## Lebanon Rescue Chief's Report for Week Ending 01/09/2010



### **Weekly Stats:**

The Lebanon Rescue Department responded to 18 calls for service during the week of Saturday 12/26/2009 to Saturday 01/09/2010. The following is a breakdown of calls: 4 Motor Vehicle Accidents, 4 Mutual Aid to Neighboring Towns, 1 Public Assist, 1 Stand By at Fire Scene (shed fire), 2 Cardiac Emergencies, 1 Unconscious Patient, 1 Suicidal Patient, 1 Water Rescue, 1 Bicycle Accident with Injury, 1 Burn Patient, and 1 Fall.

8 Patients were transported to the hospital. 4 to Goodall Hospital and 4 to Frisbie Memorial Hospital.
