## 5:30 Pledge of Allegiance

5:31 Public Participation – Corinna Cole, as a resident, shares her support of Referendum 40 – Town Manager. Ms. Cole discussed the cost and benefits to the Town to have a Town Manager. Teri Poirier addresses the post card that she received in the mail against the Marijuana Ordinances. Ms. Poirier states there is confusion as to why we need new Ordinances when the Town already on voted on this.
