- \* Per 11.6a in the Subdivision Planning Ordinance Guide, the Board needs certification that the area for each lot is large enough
- \* Per 12.5b in the Subdivision Planning Ordinance Guide, as well as by State law the certification needs to be on the final plan

**Hydrogeologic Waiver -** G. Getchell made a motion to accept the waiver. D. Batchelder seconded the motion, the vote carried.

**Brett Scott - (8:32 pm)** Mr. Scott presented the Board with an updated Shoreland Zoning Application for the proposed Coffee Drive-thru stand. The revised proposal is to operate a coffee stand only as a seasonal accessory to, and limited to operation during the open hours of, the recreational center operation. The Board has also requested that the foliage be restored by the river. C. Cone made the motion to accept the revised 12/9/2013 request for the family fun center to include a snack shack. J.
