4:00 pm – Open Meeting:

- Road Commissioner Tom Torno – roads discussion, etc.

4:15 pm:

- Sue Collins – appointment papers, sign warrant, abatements, assessing.

4:30 pm:

- Ashley Allen came in from Great Brook Drive to discuss the procedure to have the road accepted as a town road. Chairman Thompson explained that this would have to go to the Planning Board first, whereas it is an existing subdivision. He provided Ashley with paperwork regarding this.

5:00 pm:
