

- 1.) Fill out our KYCW! application and receive a referral from a general assistance office
- 2.) Be available one day for an assessment, and one day for weatherization work
- 3.) Clear areas in the home that require work or installation of the storm windows

We also encourage able-bodied homeowners or their friends and family to assist in the work performed.

**Keep York County Warm! and Habitat for Humanity York County DO NOT:**

- ○ Provide heating assistance
- ○ Replace appliances
- ○ Replace windows, doors or siding
- ○ Install ANY insulation other than foam board around the basement sill or over attic hatch
- ○ Do any electrical or plumbing work
- ○ Do any work in attics with the exception of work on the attic hatch
- ○ Work on roofs
- ○ Do major weatherization projects. Volunteers spend no more than 2.5 hours at each home.

**Homeowners who might benefit most from this program may:**

- ○ Have windows that are in poor condition
- ○ Have the inability to perform work themselves due to illness, age, or other lack of resources
- ○ Be awaiting more extensive weatherization work from YCCA
