**About Keep York County Warm:**

Keep York County Warm! (KYCW!), provides custom fit storm windows and small weatherization repairs at no cost to York County homeowners eligible for LIHEAP. The weatherization work is performed by small teams of community volunteers, church groups, or high school students.

**Qualified homeowners receive:**

- 1.) A home assessment
- 2.) Educational materials
- 3.) Notes on the work to be performed
- 4.) Up to 6 custom-fit storm windows.
- 5.) The installation of weatherization materials such as: door sweeps, pipe insulation, outlet gaskets and covers, foam board insulation around the basement sill, spray foam and caulk for gaps and cracks
- 6.) Small weatherization-related repairs such as adjusting a crooked door.
- 7.) Consideration for more extensive weatherization work from Habitat
