5:30 Pledge of Allegiance

5:31 Deb Wilson reminds residents that Meet the Candidates night is 6/30/2020 and this is not a Town Sponsored Event. Jennifer Bozak is here to discuss the Noise Ordinance that is up for vote. Ms. Bozak feels that this is not inclusive of all the issues, such as, fireworks and firearms. Chair Russell explains that there are State Laws regarding discharging firearms after dark. Chair Russell also states that he feels that if the Ordinance was too restrictive it wouldn't pass.

5:42 Selectman Bragg motioned to accept the minutes of 6/18/2020 as written. Selectman Philbrick seconded. Vote taken; vote carried.

5:43 Paperwork: Signed time off requests and appointment paperwork.

5:50 Selectman Bragg reminds BOS about having a hole cut in the glass out front to help with communication between customers and public. Chair Russell advises that he looked into this and it would be very expensive, he is looking into other options. Selectman Bragg speaks to the paperwork submitted by applicants to the Appeals Board. Selectman Bragg addresses Deb Wilson, Chair of the Appeals Board that there is no law stating that the Appeals Board members can't get this ahead of time. Selectman Bragg confirmed this with MMA Legal. Selectman Bragg feels that the Appeals Board isn't able to make the best-informed decision about the case unless they are able to read the paperwork ahead of time. Ms. Wilson states it is the law and she agrees it would be better if they could get the documents ahead of time. Chairman Russell advises that the Town Attorney states they are legally able to get paperwork ahead of time and that they should.

Chair Russell states that he has reached out to Lt. Ross of Maine State Police regarding the ATV issues, but hasn't heard back yet.
