➤ **Ref 37** - Shall the Town of Lebanon vote to transfer up to \$90,000.00 from the Restricted Fund Balance to fund over expenditures in the 2020-2021 fiscal year budget. Discussion occurred regarding what does the \$90,000 cover. Currently Sel. Philbrick estimates \$20-30k for Fire, \$10k for legal on top of \$10k already used from Contingency, and \$20-25K for transfer station. Contingency currently has between \$35-40k but this has been earmarked for something that Sel. Philbrick was not at liberty to discuss. Concerns were raised as to the fund balance in the General Fund. Discussion was also held regarding the Transfer station overage.
