Old Business

- 3. Community Forest management plan:
 - a. John reported that he spoke to Selectman Paul Philbrick regarding the budgeted \$1500.00 for the management plan. John reports that Brian Reader (Forester) will be starting his work soon and will have this completed by the end of June, therefore there is no need to roll the \$1500.00 over to next year's budget. The deadline for completion for the grant remains 12/2023.
 - b. There was again discussion and agreement that we would work to brush out the Sacopee Trail this upcoming spring once the weather and road conditions allow.
 - c. Trail head sign: John has gone over to Burpee Signs of Sanford to get new signs made. These should be completed in a week or 2 and be ready for spring.

- 5. Town budgeted money for Transfer station:
 - a. Jerry reported that he had spoken to selectmen Philbrick and Walsworth who clarified that the \$1500.00 was for transfer station improvements, not just for recycling. Jerry will contact Selectman Walsworth in the near future to discuss a time for a site visit to the transfer station.
