Keep York County Warm Program Updates

Keep York County Warm! provides weatherization service at no cost for up to 40 pre-qualified low-income homeowners each year. In past years Keep York County Warm! has provided homeowners with \$250 of volunteer based weatherization services.

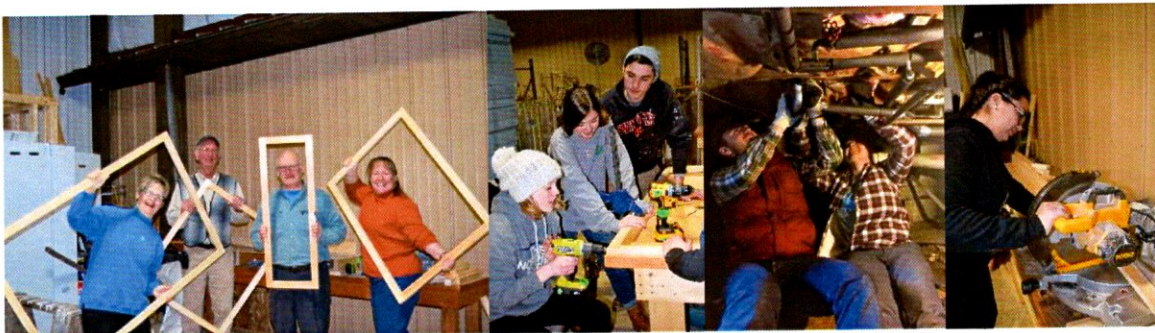
Starting in Fall 2017 Habitat for Humanity will utilize rebates from Efficiency Maine's Low-Income Home Energy Savings Program. By partnering with Efficiency Maine and local energy auditors homeowners will receive professional level of weatherization services. Each homeowner will receive \$1,050 of weatherization services, including CO and smoke detectors if none are present in the home. Additionally Habitat will continue to provide storm window inserts to homeowners with drafty windows. Working with rebates requires us to use stricter eligibility standards, in the first year of the program we will continue to provide volunteer based services for homeowners who qualified in the past, but not with the rebate program.

As a result of the program changes Keep York County Warm! will be providing weatherization services year round. It is never too early to start preparing for winter. Enclosed is a copy of our program referral form with the income qualification guidelines. A PDF of the referral form can be found on our website, www.habitatyorkcounty.org.
