Weatherization Program Registration Form

Habitat for Humanity York County's weatherization program, Keep York County Warm! (KYCW!), has partnered with The Heat Doctors, STP Home Performance Solutions and Efficiency Maine to provide professional energy audits and air sealing at **no-cost** to York County homeowners.

Home Owner Eligibility: One of the following must apply in order to receive funding from Efficiency Maine

- LIHEAP Participant
- Are income eligible for LIHEAP
- Own and live in a single- or double-wide mobile home
- Assessed value of property is less than or equal to \$80,000. Copy of tax bill or town tax commitment
- Have received financial or general assistance within the last year

Step 2: Obtain a Referral: Please obtain a signature for the referral statement below. The signature must be from a General Assistance officer, outreach worker, CAP agency, YCCAC or the Southern Maine Agency on Aging.
